Cookie Policy

1. Introduction

You may not have given any thought to how websites use data to improve their services, measure how popular the site is, or make sure that you receive content or adverts of interest to you.

These processes require information to be collected and processed. This commonly includes information about the devices you use (such as laptops and mobile phones) and information obtained from your browsing activities. This information is collected using cookies (small files of data sent by websites, stored on your device and read by websites).

For the purposes of this cookie policy, we use the term "cookie" to cover our use of all types of similar technology used to monitor online activity, including cookies, tags, pixels and beacons. We hope that this policy helps you understand and feel more confident about our use of cookies.

2. This policy

This is the cookie policy for the TruFin plc website (www.trufin.com) (this/our "Site") and we hope that it helps you to understand our use of cookies. You can read more about our use of personal data in our privacy policy, available on our Site.

Our Site uses cookies to distinguish you from other users of our Site. This helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse our Site and also allows us to improve our Site and our services since we can learn about what interests our website visitors and – just as importantly – what doesn't.

This policy also covers the cookies that we place in our marketing emails. This helps us to understand which emails are opened, which are ignored, and which types of content prompts people to click through to our Site.

3. The types of cookie that we use

- Strictly necessary cookies. These cookies are required for the operation of our Site.
- Analytical/performance cookies. These cookies allow us to recognise and count the
 number of visitors to our Site and to see how visitors move around our Site when they are
 using it. This helps us to improve the way our Site works, for example, by ensuring that
 users can find what they are looking for easily. All information collected by these cookies is
 aggregated (i.e. we could not identify you as an individual using the data).

Some of the cookies that we use are deleted when you close your browser. These cookies are known as 'session cookies'.

We have included a table at the end of this policy showing all of the cookies that we use on the Site if you would like more detail.

4. Third party cookies

Please note that third parties (including, for example, providers of external services like web traffic analysis services) may also place cookies on our Site, over which we have no control. These cookies are likely to be analytical/performance cookies or targeting cookies.

For example, we use Google Analytics to learn how visitors are using our Site and how we could improve it. 5. Managing cookies

When you access our Site for the first time you will see our cookie consent mechanism which describes the types of cookies we use and what information they might collect. We will not place (and we won't permit third parties to place) cookies other than "strictly necessary" cookies on your device or browser when using our Site unless you have told us that you are happy for us to do so using our cookie consent mechanism.

If you do change your mind and choose to reject some or all cookie types, please note that we won't be able to remove any cookies that have already been deployed to your device. You can remove cookies that have already been deployed by engaging with the settings of the browser on which you have accessed our Site.

You can also block cookies using your browser settings. However, if you use your browser settings to block *all* cookies (including strictly necessary cookies) you may not be able to access or use all or parts of our Site.
